Brooklyn-born, Rasheen Hill, working under the pseudonym, R.H.Bless, is a writer of features and episodic dramas. R.H creates works in a variety of media, from screenplays to commercials, to music videos, and films.

R.H. made his independent feature film directorial debut with <u>Easter Sunday</u> (2014) which he also wrote and produced and has since written and directed such films as <u>Something Unorthodox</u> (2016), <u>Hope Well</u> (2018), and <u>Father Be With Us</u> (2019), all currently available on Amazon Prime Video.

R.H.'s production company, Block Exchange Ent & Films, has produced over 100 music videos for many independent and established artists since 2007, over 10 short film projects, 7 documentaries, and promo commercials.

R.H. began as a lyricist and independent Hip Hop artist in New York in the early '90s and has toured and performed alongside a host of notable Hip-Hop artists. After writing treatments for and directing countless music videos for himself as well as various artists from East to West coast, he evolved into a cinematographer and guerrilla-style independent filmmaker. Later, he went on to hone his craft and pursued higher education in cinematography, directing, screenwriting, and creative writing at Full Sail University, where he earned his BA in Digital Cinematography and MFA in Creative Writing.
